

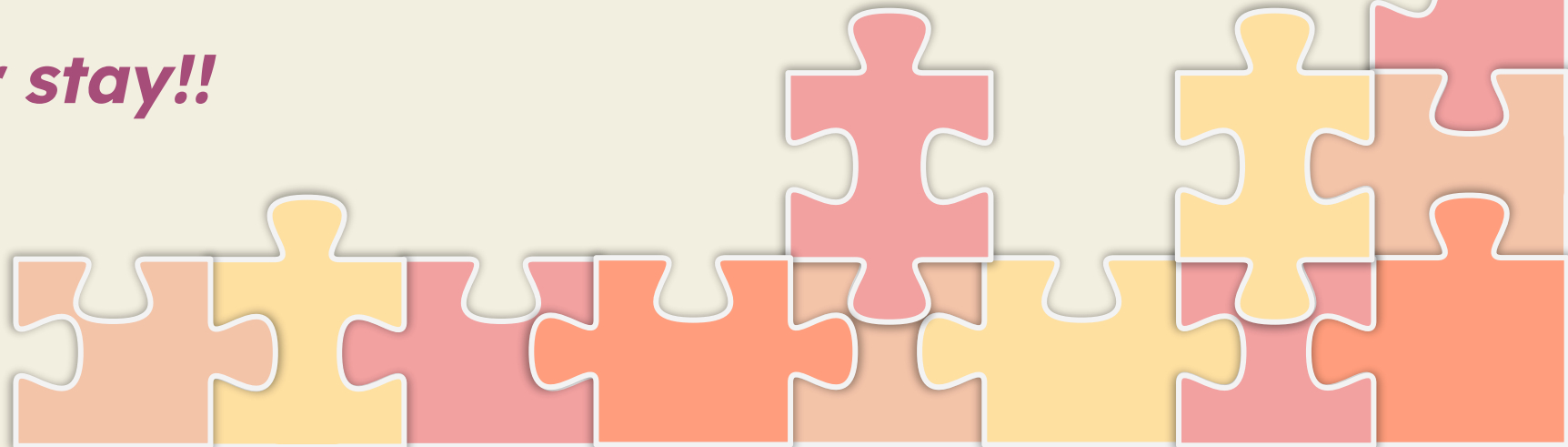


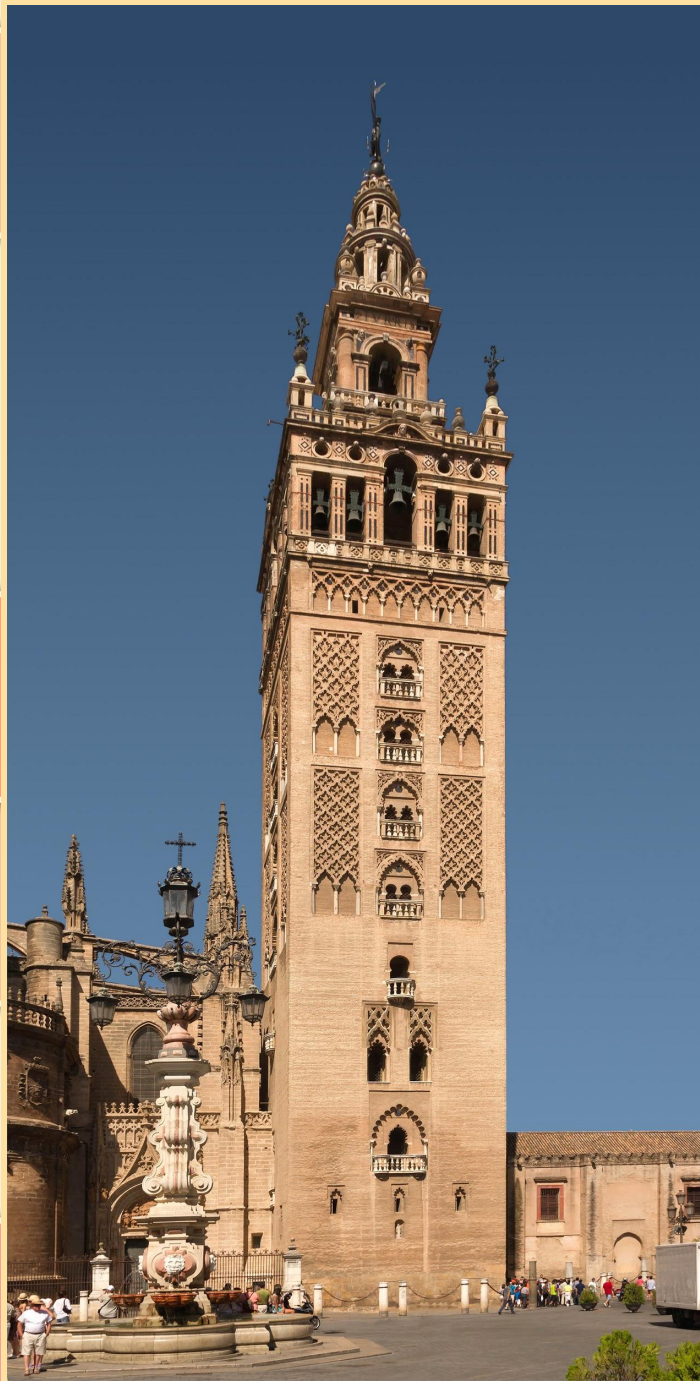

Julio Cesar fell in love with Híspalis (the name by which it was known at that time).

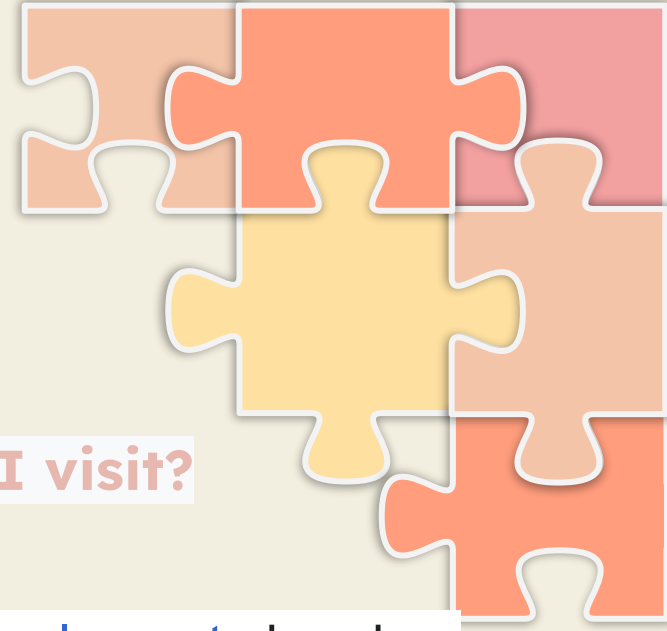
It was the capital of the Almohad empire around 711 when it stretched from Libya to Cataluña.

# Fair of April in Seville

**Holy Week in Seville** (In Spanish: *Semana Santa de Sevilla*) is one of two biggest annual festivals in [Seville](#), the other being the *Feria de Abril* (April Fair), which follows two weeks later.

The fair officially begins at midnight on Saturday, and runs seven days, ending on the following Saturday. Each day the [fiesta](#) begins with the [parade](#) of carriages and riders

# Flamenco Dancing

Sevillanas are danced by couples of all ages and sexes during celebrations (*fiestas* or *ferias*), often by whole families and towns. Sevillana choreography is characterized by stability and functionality, since it is a festival dance. This is why those intending to dance flamenco usually start by learning sevillanas; they are easier to master and there are more occasions for practice and training.

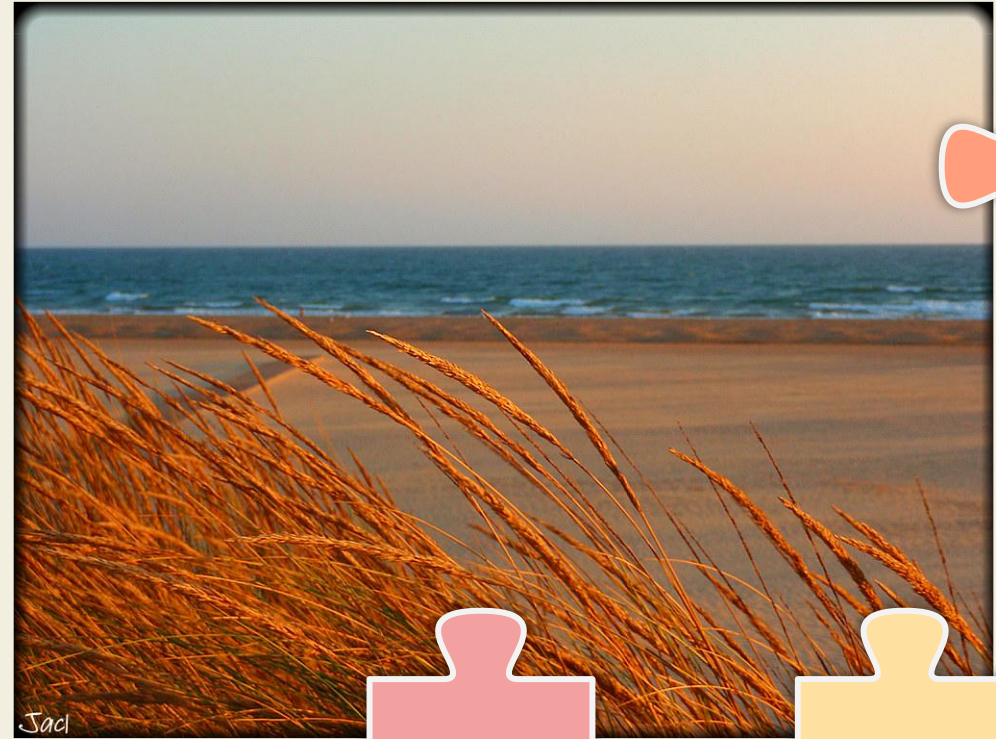

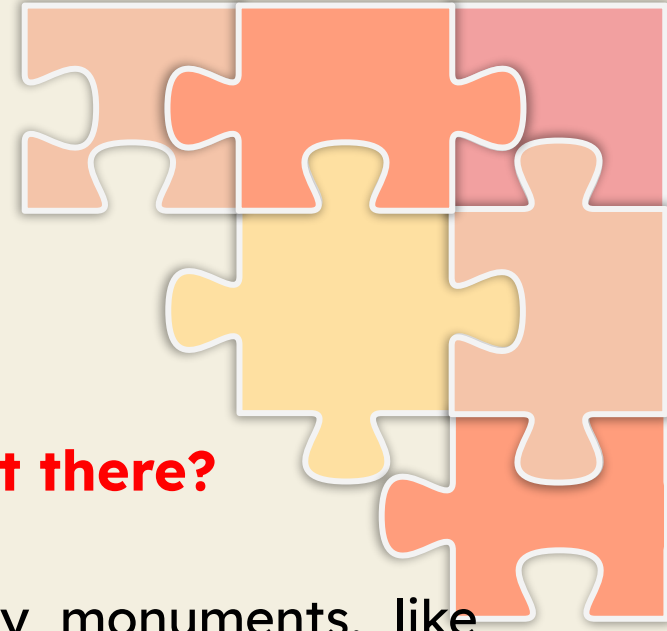


# I'm Carmen

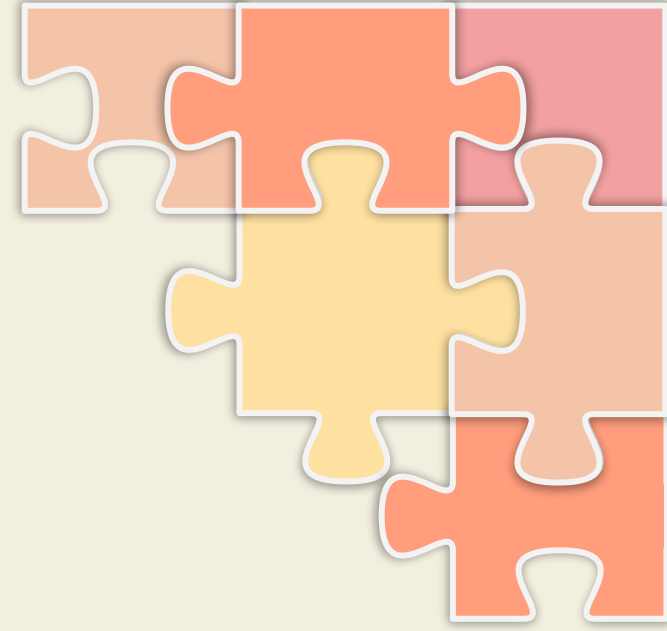

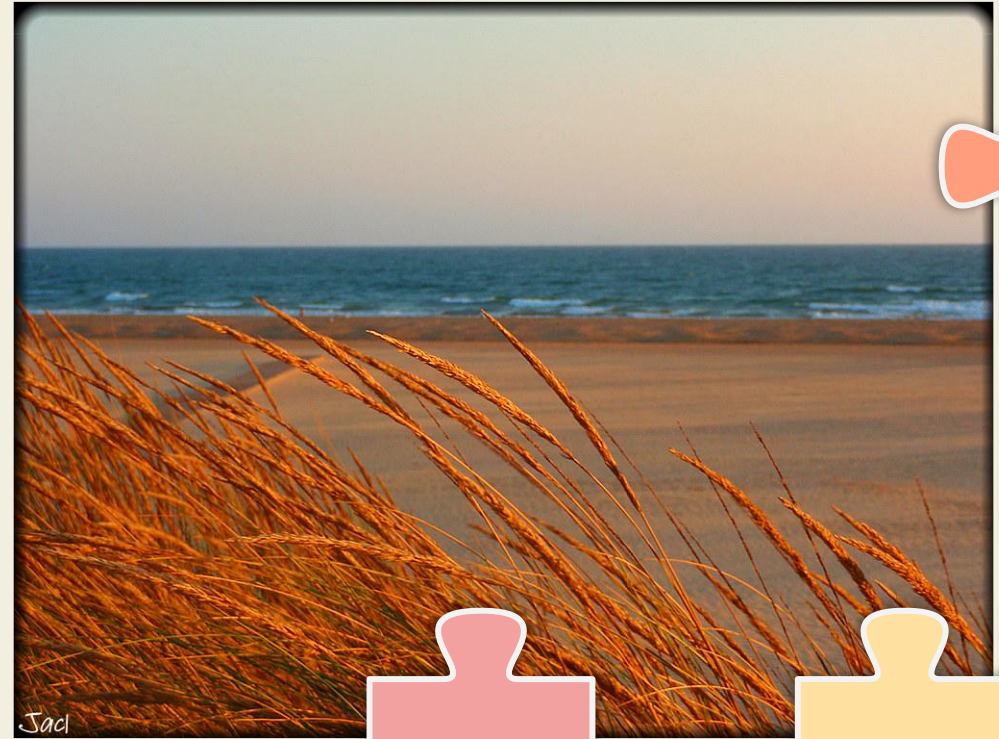
